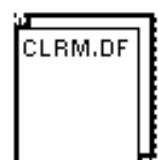
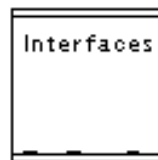


# Cedar Language

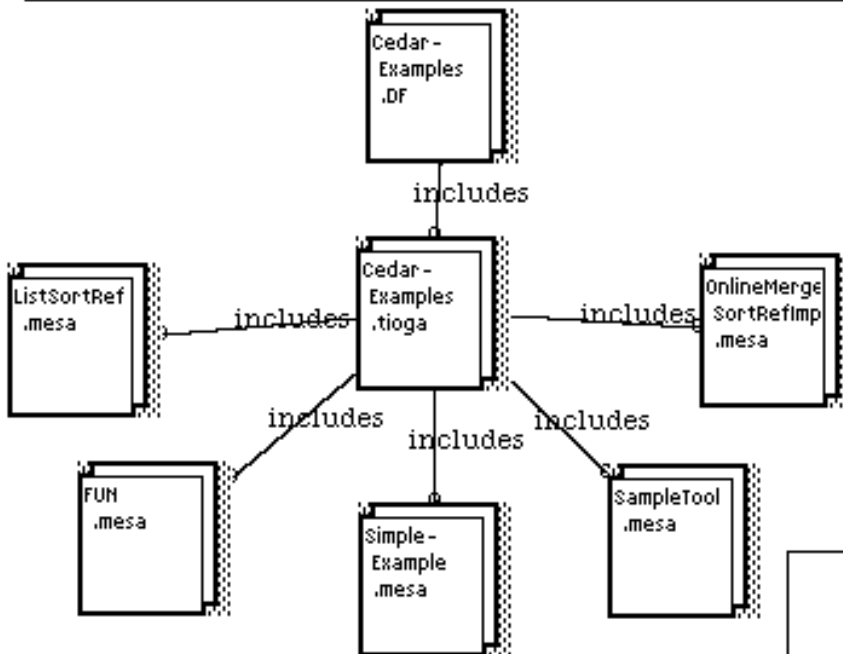
