The file MOUSECONFIRM.DCOM contains one function and one cursor definition to be used for confirming a menu selection of some import (e.g. what's being asked for is computationally expensive).

(MOUSECONFIRM PROMPTSTRING)

Replaces the cursor with a "little mouse" whose left button is wider than the middle or right. If PROMPTSTRING is NIL then the string

"LEFT button for 'yes' - MIDDLE or RIGHT button for 'no'."

is printed in the prompt window, otherwise PROMPTSTRING is printed. It then waits for the user to press and release one of the mouse buttons. If the last one released was the LEFT button, then MOUSECONFIRM returns T, otherwise it returns NIL.
